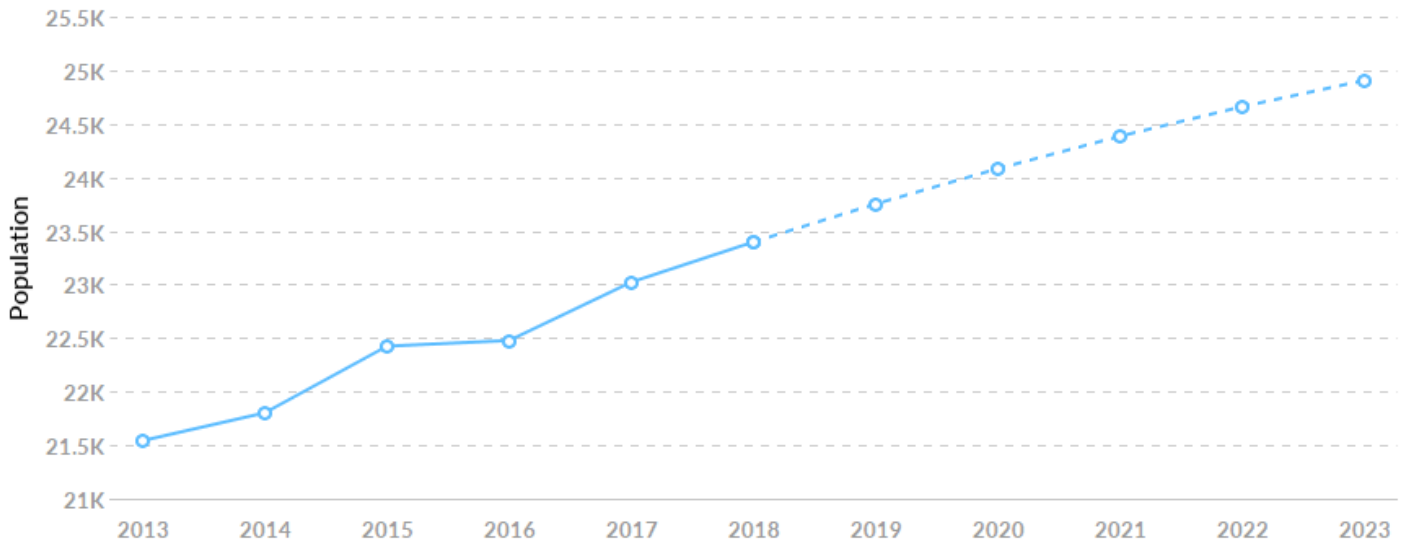

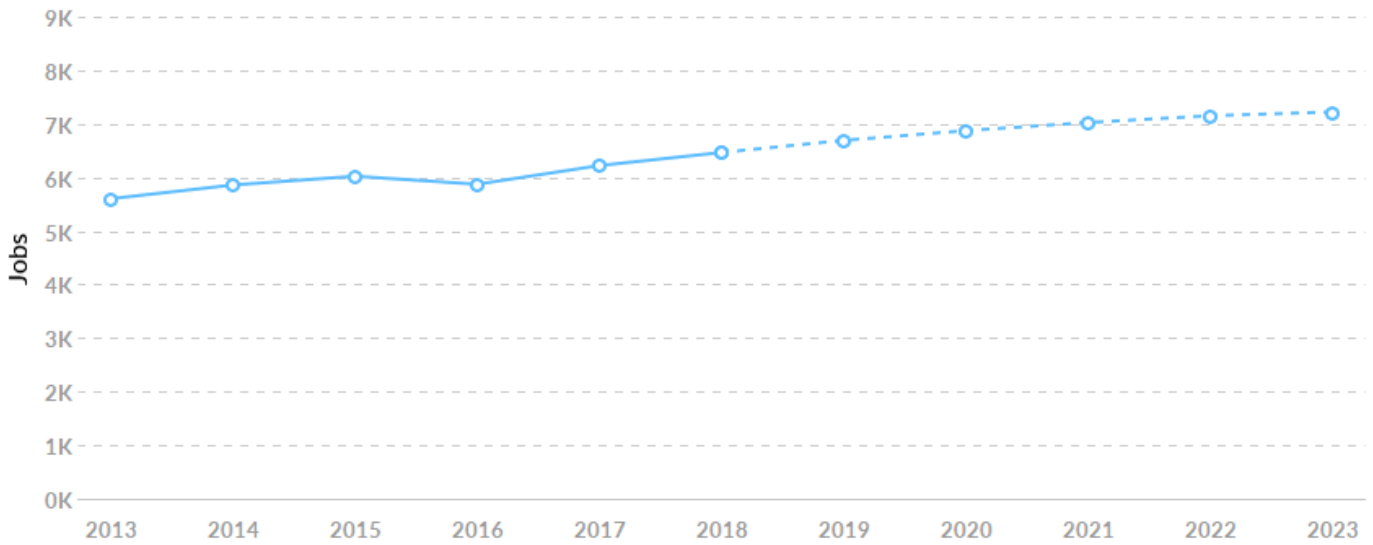

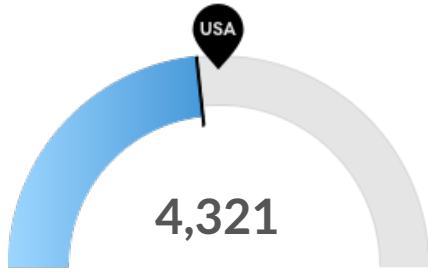
Job Trends

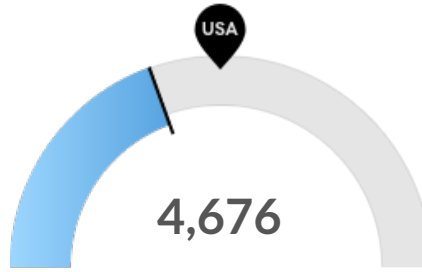

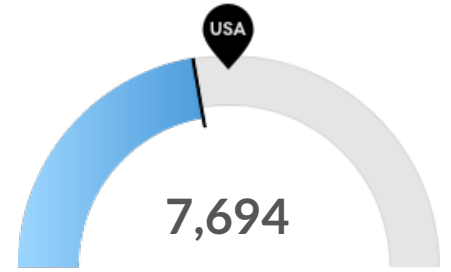
Millennials

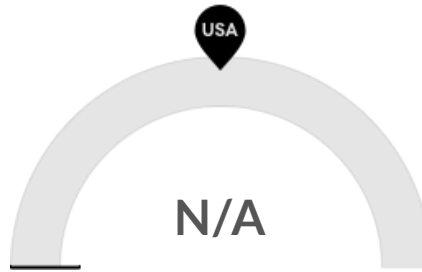

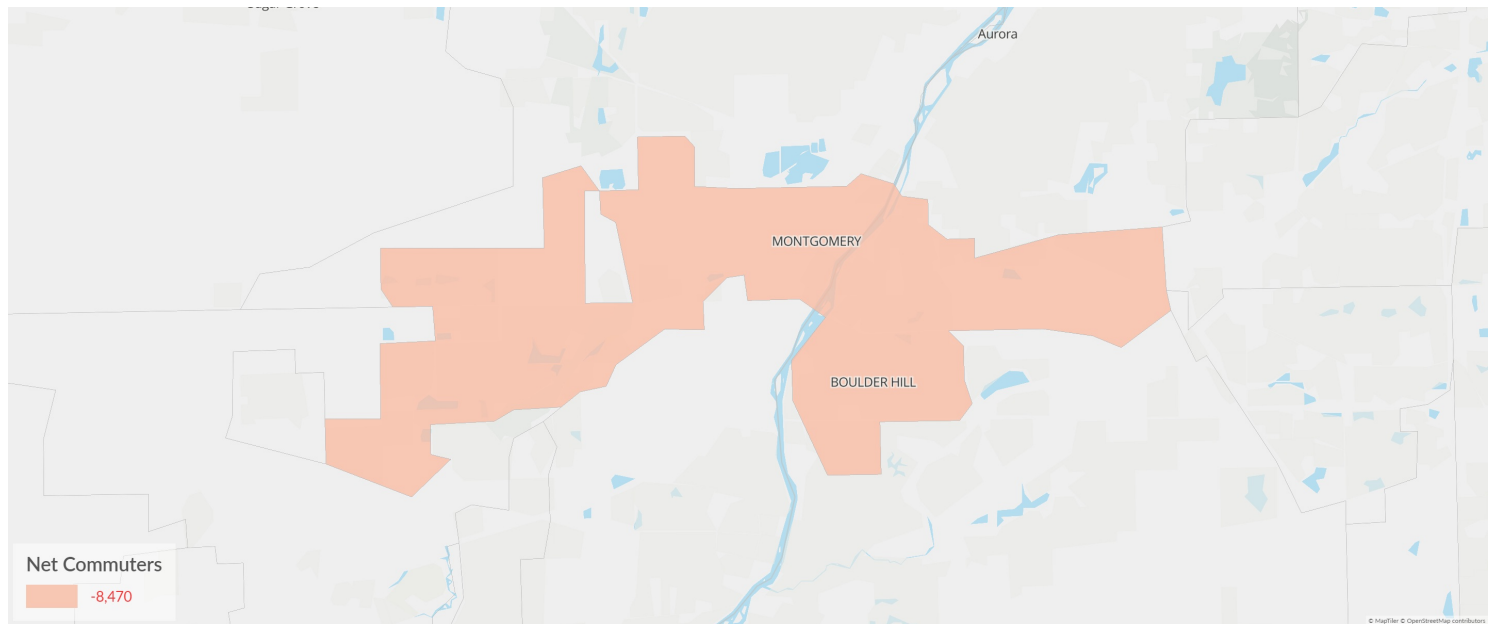

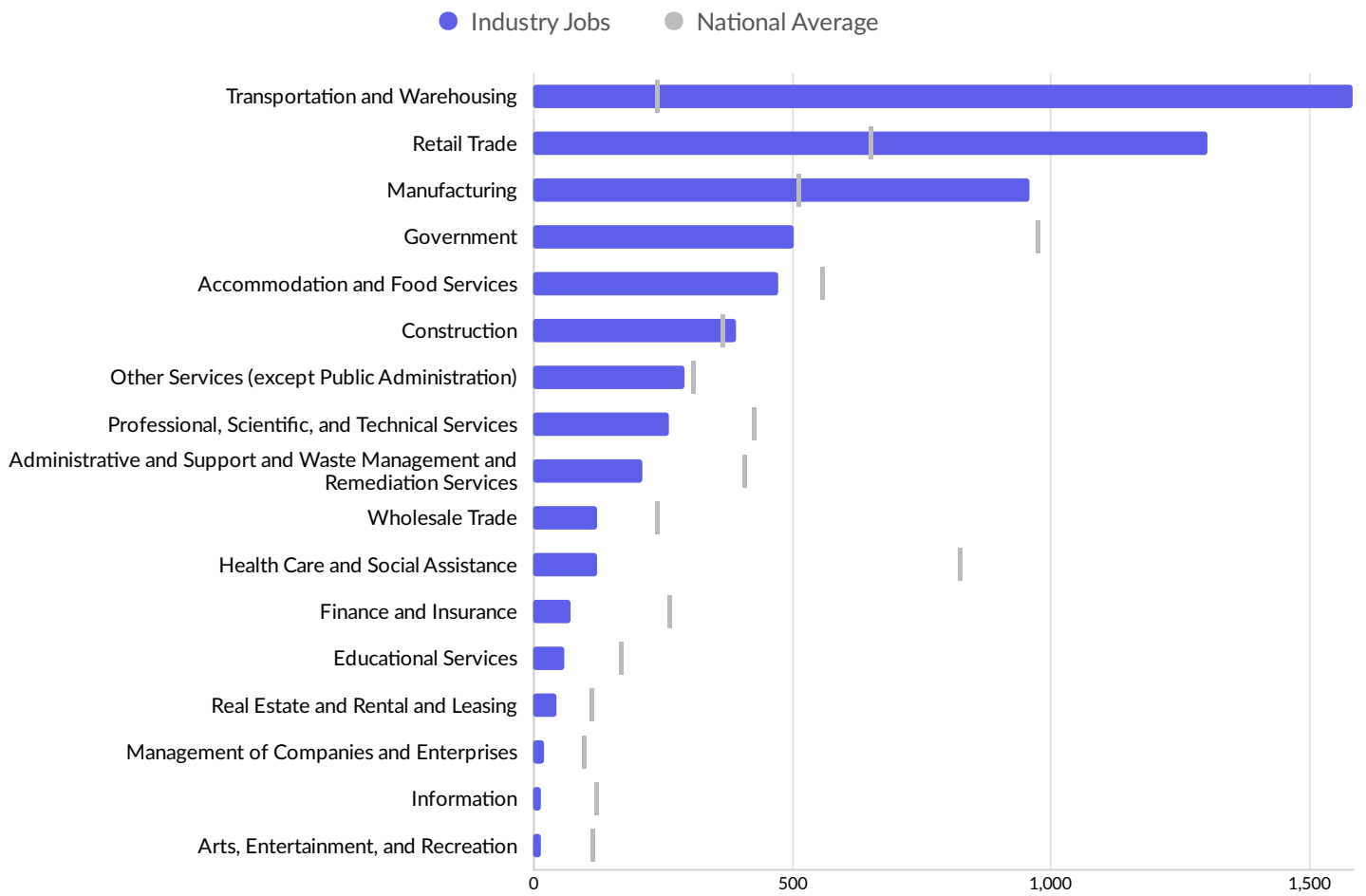

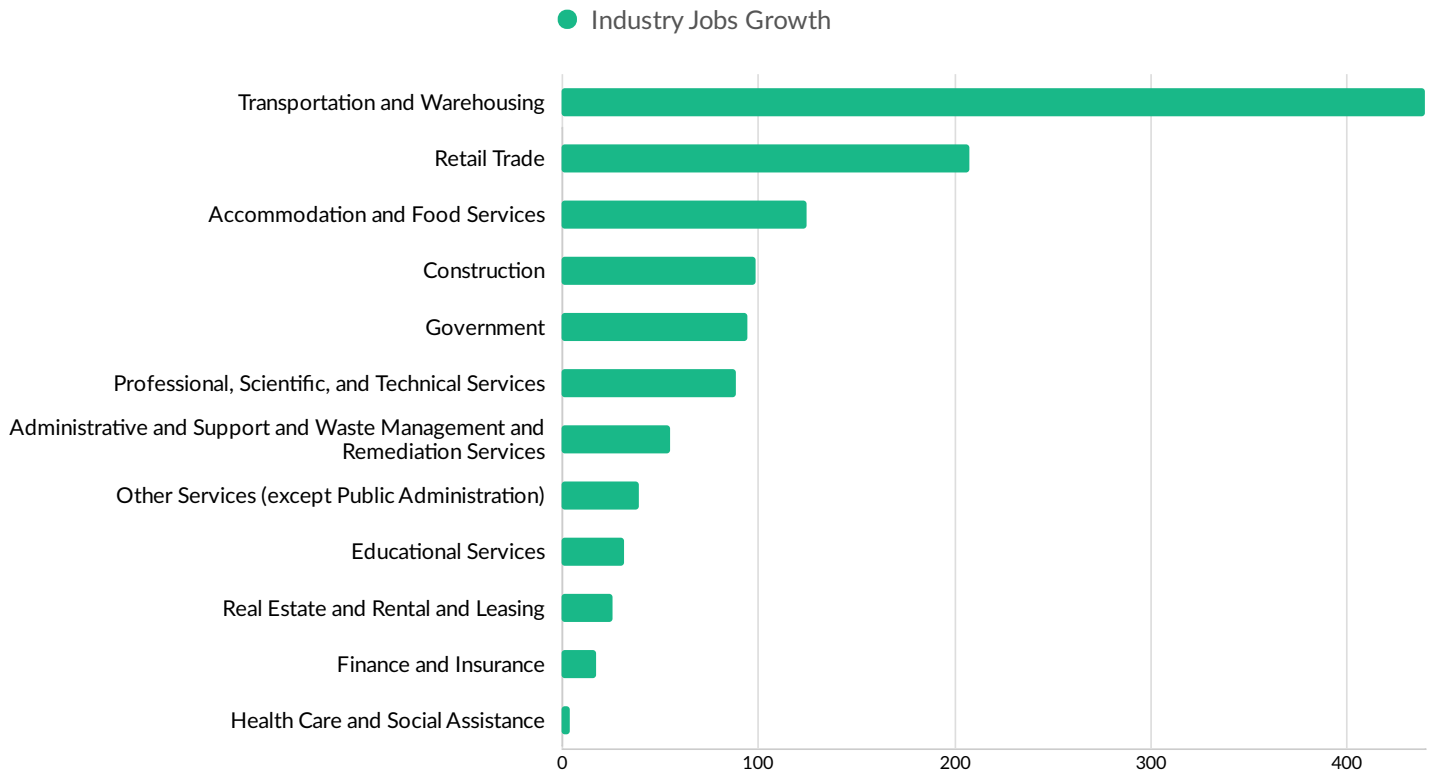

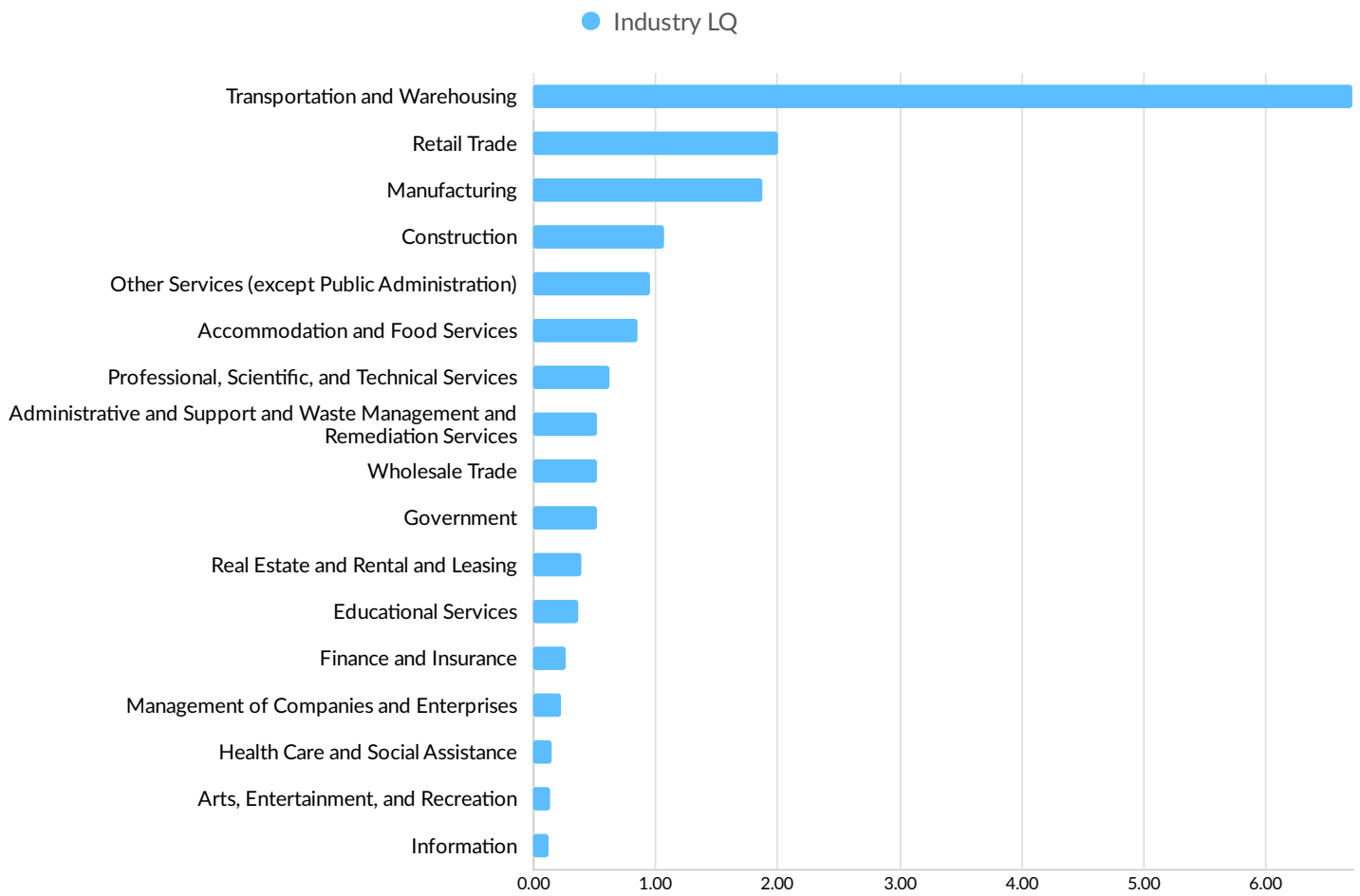

Top Growing Industries



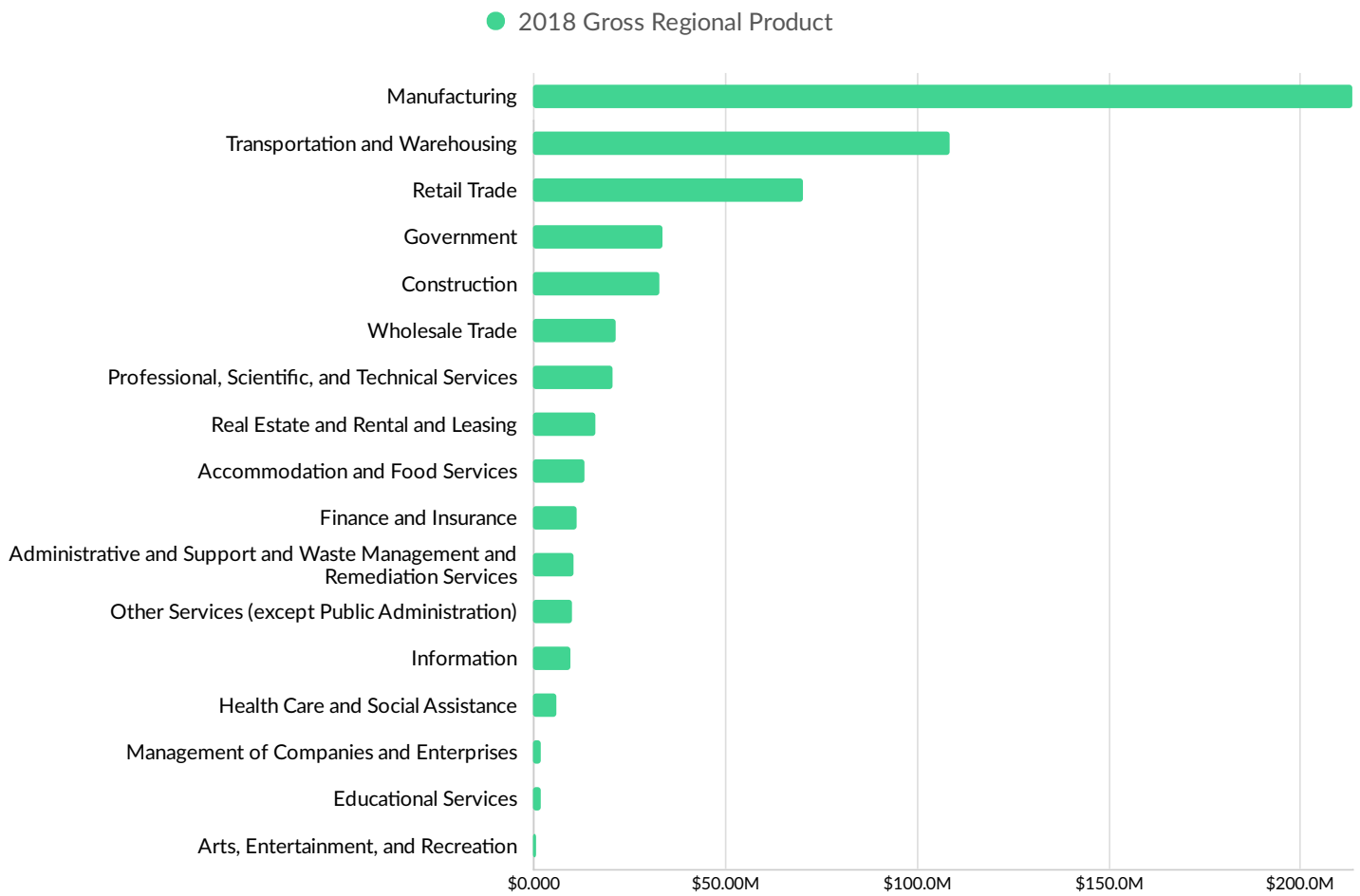

Top Industry LQ



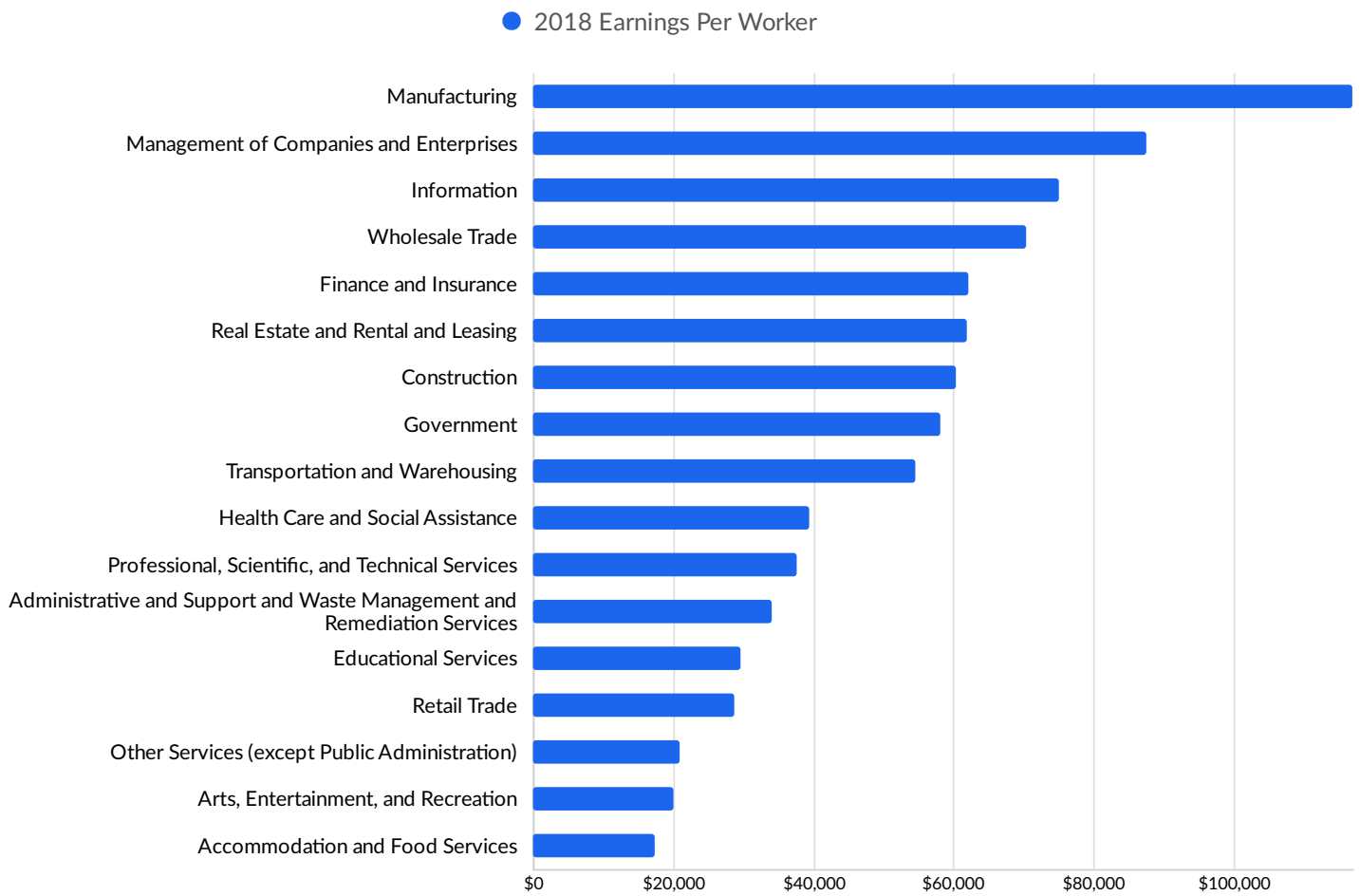

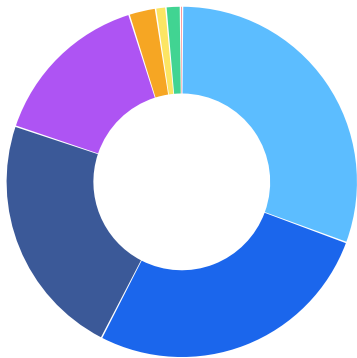

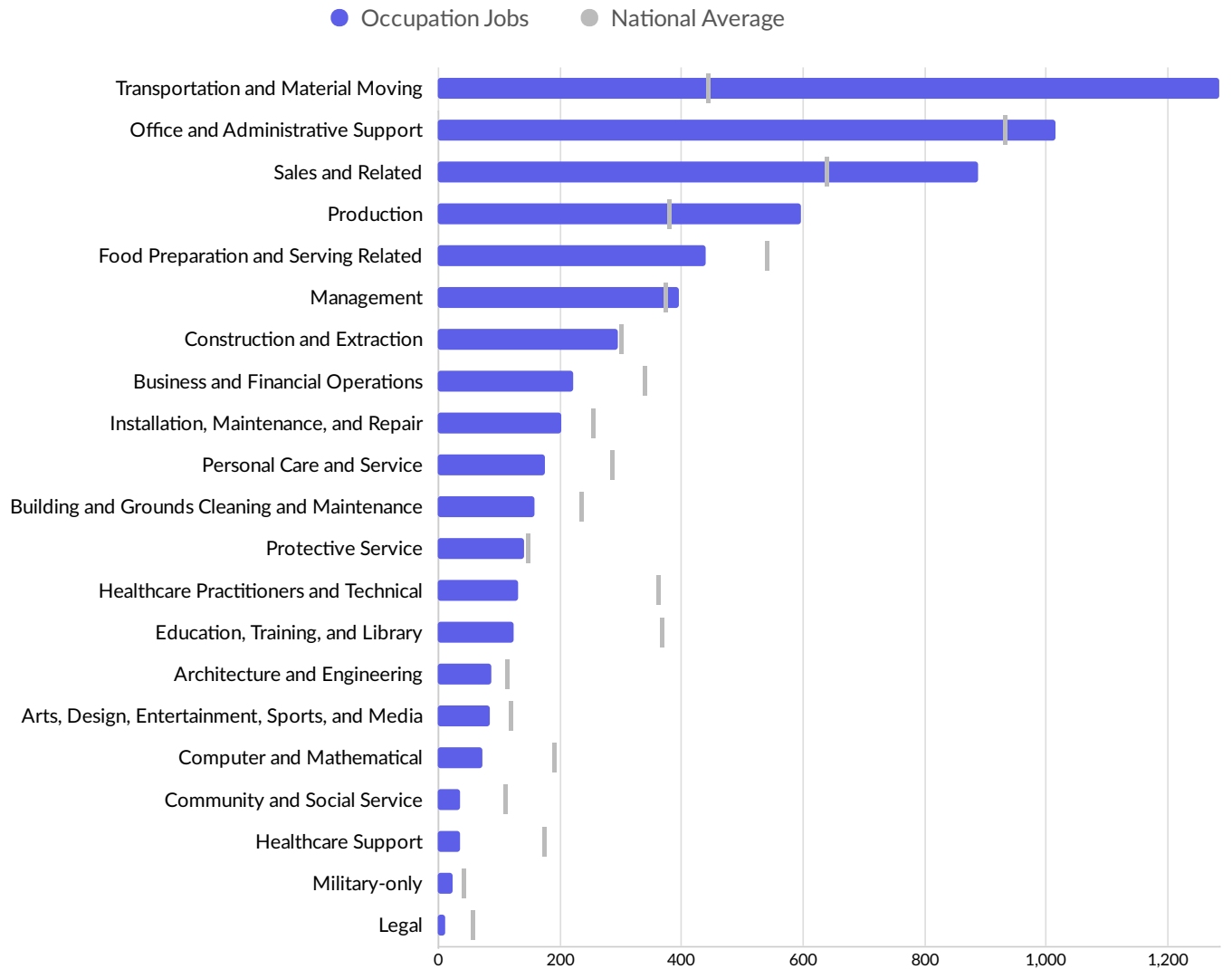

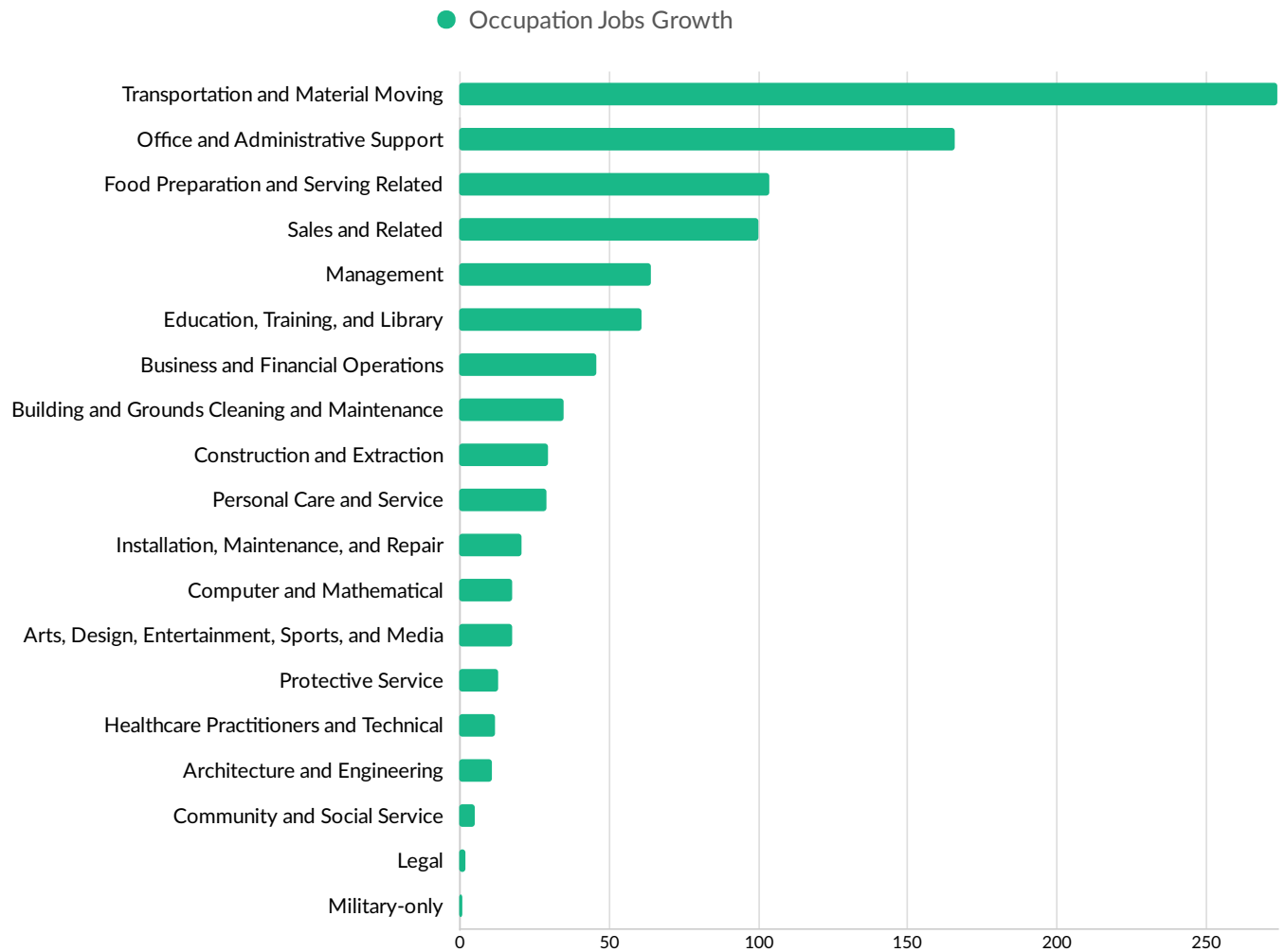

Largest Occupations



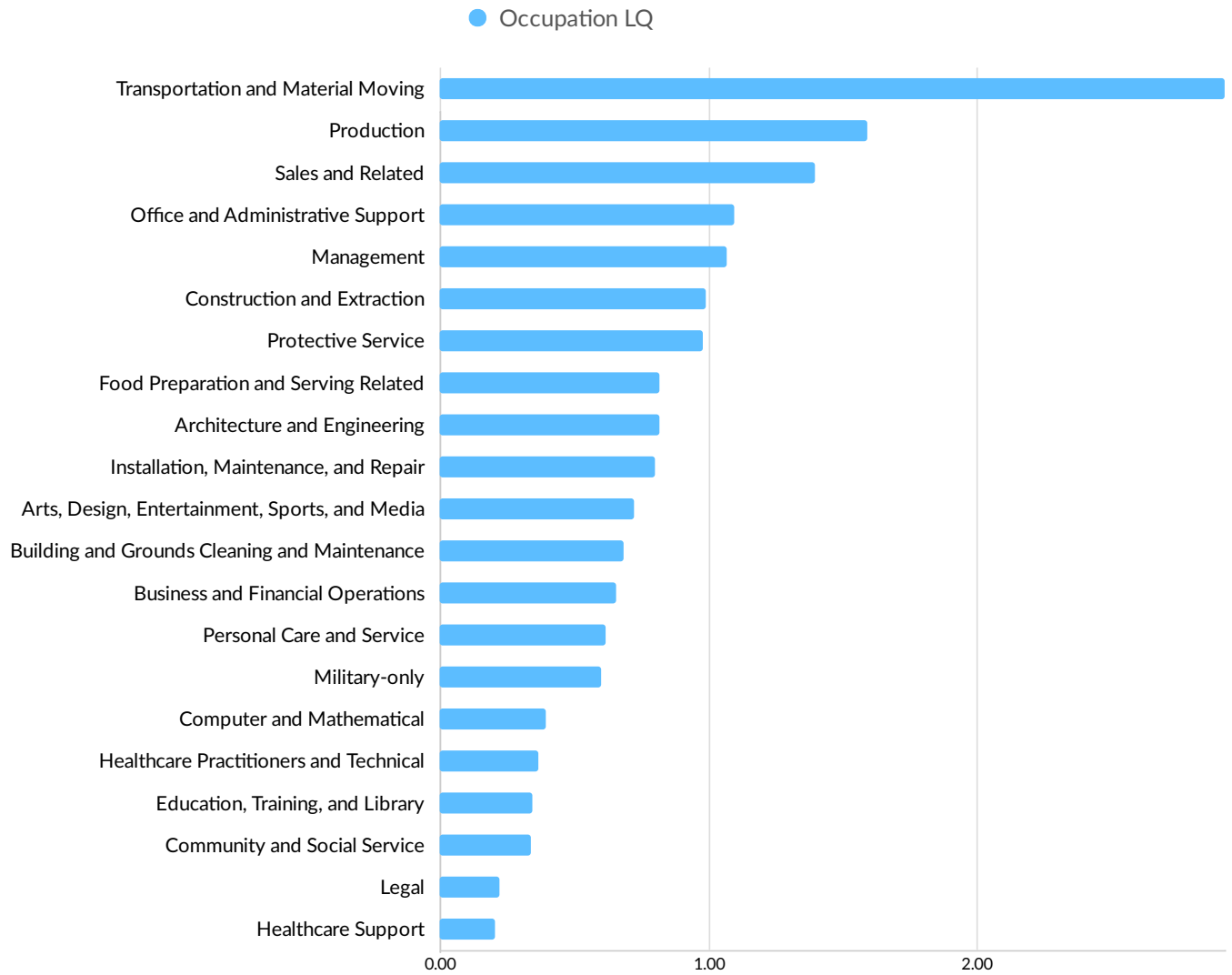

Top Growing Occupations



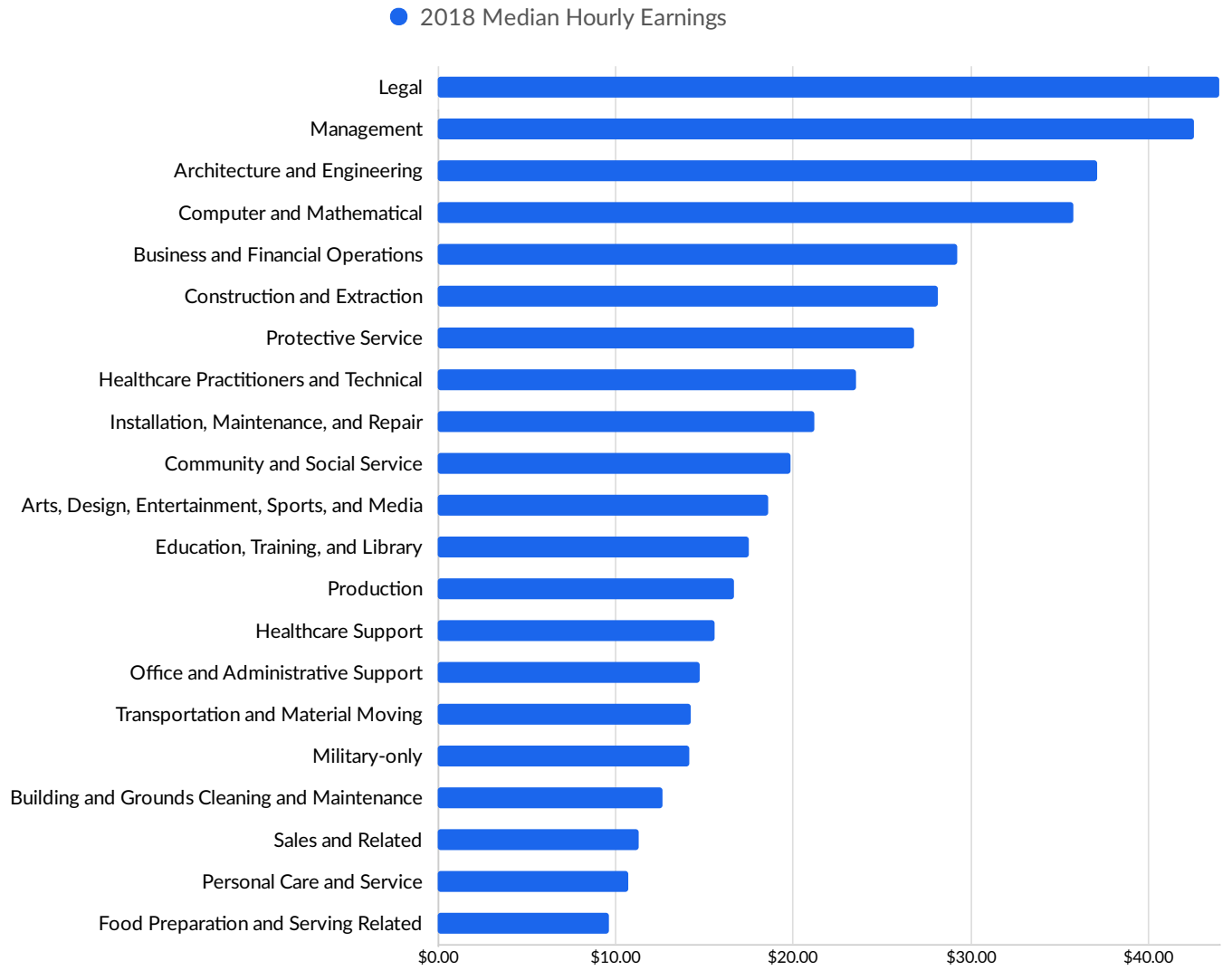
